A **Boundless Playground** is a place where children and adults of ALL abilities can come together and experience the wonder of play in a safe, barrier-free environment. Teambuilding & Challenge Course



The **Ropes Course**, which is so often referred to as a challenge or confidence course, is a group of structures developed into what are known as elements. A teambuilding and leadership program is based on a series of challenges and tasks designed to encourage cooperation, trust, communication, self confidence and the ability to work with others to achieve mutual goals.



The South Windsor Public Education Fund (SWPEF) is a program of the Foundation. The purpose is to provide funds to support projects and programs for the South Windsor Public Schools, to enhance the learning experience and encourage creativity and innovation both for students and teachers at all levels and grades. The Fund solicits gifts and grants and engages in fundraising to provide resources dedicated to benefit South Windsor public education. The Public Education Fund was ENDORSED by the South Windsor Board of Education in May 2006. In September 2007 the SWPEF established a signature fundraiser called "The Longest Dinner Table in Connecticut". This event raised over \$17,000 for the education fund which will be granted directly to South Windsor Public Schools.

The South Windsor Innovation Fund is a perpetual charitable fund created to benefit the public high school in South Windsor by enhancing and advancing innovation in education. This program is a perpetual endowment and grants and distributions shall be made to or for the benefit of South Windsor High School

The Ladies Professional Golfers Association (LPGA) USGA is a developmental junior golf program for girls ages 7-17. The program was formed to create a network for girls to play golf, build friendships and sample competition in a positive and supportive learning environment. This is the only national initiative of its kind just for girls to help them achieve success, progress in golf and establish a life long interest in the game.
